

BAPTIST YOUTH CAMPS

Each year Baptist Youth organise a programme of camps for children and young people. The emphasis of camp is to provide a holiday in a Christian environment, with the vital dimension of teaching the children the unchanging truth of Jesus Christ.

Programmes are planned to appeal to everyone. Swimming, day trips, crafts, outdoor and indoor games are on offer at most camps as well as the more specialised activities in the adventure camp.

Baptist Youth camps are staffed by volunteers from all walks of life but who all know Jesus as Rescuer and King. A rigorous process of application in line with BY's child protection policy is undertaken for all officers on our camps (copies of the policy are available by contacting Baptist Youth).

Baptist Youth, as a department of the Association of Baptist Churches in Ireland, have an insurance policy which covers Employers Liability and Public Liability. The Association will arrange a travel and personal accident policy to cover those travelling outside Northern Ireland. However, all those taking part in camps are advised to consider additional insurance for themselves.

Sometimes photographs and/or video taken on Baptist Youth Camps are used in publicity materials or may be put on the Baptist Youth website. If you have any objection to photographs and/or video of your child being used for such purposes please inform the Youth Director in writing by 30 June 2010.

Ages of children attending camp should be assessed as of 30 June 2010. Rules relating to age will be strictly observed.

Camp places are limited so book early to avoid disappointment!
